Animal Technologist Grade 52

Summary

Performs duties related to specialized animal care or colonies.

Typical Duties

- Maintains animal facilities and animal health in specialized areas such as breeding colonies and controlled environments.
- 2. Keeps records of animal care, identification, weights, temperatures, food consumption, pertaining to a research project, production colony, or other specialized animal care.
- 3. Handles difficult and/or hazardous animals.
- 4. Assists in certain experimental procedures under the direct supervision of a professional instructor (e.g. anesthesia, euthanasia, injection, perfusion).
- 5. May order food, supplies, and animals.
- 6. Performs related duties as required.

Typical Requirements

Education: American Association of Laboratory Animal Science certificate as a technologist. Some undergraduate training in animal management or biological science preferred.

Skills and Experience: Six or more years of experience in animal care or equivalent.
