# **Environmental Health and Safety Technician II Grade 51**

## Summary

Performs moderately complex technical duties related to the assessment of environmental conditions within the University's facilities and/or affiliated hospitals to ensure compliance with established federal, state, and University regulations.

# **Typical Duties**

- 1. Measures environmental factors (e.g., pollutants/contaminants), using field or laboratory detection instruments to determine levels.
- 2. Monitors environmental conditions through inspection or survey.
- 3. Identifies and notifies supervisor about possible environmental problems and may recommend appropriate solutions.
- 4. Completes appropriate paperwork and issues reports.
- 5. Performs related job duties as required.

### **Typical Requirements**

*Education:* High school graduate or equivalent and course work related to environmental science preferred.

Skills and Experience: Two to three years' related work experience preferred. Driver's license may be required (Certification may also be a requisite depending on the type of environmental factors involved).
