Summary

Performs a variety of skilled duties to tune, maintain, and rebuild University pianos.

Typical Duties

- 1. Tunes piano strings using tuning hammer and fork.
- 2. Repairs or replaces parts such as broken strings, hammers, action parts, tuning pins, and pedal mechanisms.
- 3. Assists in assessing condition of pianos and rebuilding/refinishing pianos in the shop (e.g., restores the action, replaces leather and felt, replaces strings and worn parts, resurfaces and refinishes wooden parts).
- 4. Tunes pianos for University-sponsored recitals, making changes as required by the performer.5. Performs related job duties as required.

Typical Requirements

Education: Certification from a piano technician program recognized by the Piano Technician's Guild.

Skills and Experience: Some related experience preferred.
